**Silmy Karim: Immigration Cooperation with VFS Global for the Digitalization of Immigration Services**

JAKARTA – The Directorate General (Ditjen) of Immigration inaugurated cooperation with VFS Global, the largest company for immigration services, on Wednesday (16/10/2024). Immigration services on the VFS Global website will start operating in December 2024, just before the year-end holiday season. The two parties not only cooperate in services but also in increasing the interest of foreign nationals to visit Indonesia through various promotional programs.

To facilitate access for foreigners to obtain visas, the Directorate General of Immigration has implemented online-based services. "Now, we are further increasing our service reach by opening application access through VFS Global," said Silmy Karim.
